THE CALL FOR EVANGELISM Reverend C. Nadir Powell



Would you agree that we are living in some times of trouble? We really are. There are economic challenges, social and racial injustice, Healthcare struggles, political polarization where there's division. separation, opposition between political groups and groups of people. In addition, there's voters suppression, and distrust in the government, gun violence, educational systems are struggling because of certain mandates coming from the administration in Washington DC, fundings are being cut which is destroying organizations who seek to help marginalized or oppressed

are being snatched away, there are homelessness. drug addiction crisis, taxes are going up, and the prices of food has gone up. Even worse, there's a spiritual crisis in America, meaning there's a decline or a lack of belief in God. Christianity has seen a decline from 2007 to the present. The Pew Research Center reported that in 2007. Christian believers were about 78% of the population. By 2014 believers dropped to 71%. From 2023 to 2024 believers dropped to 62% showing a 16% drop. Using the method that they use to determine these declines, the Pew Research Center anticipates by 2050, Christian believers will drop to 47% and will continue to drop if something doesn't change. Looking at this, there should be some concern when it comes to
